Day One: Cornwall Weekend featuring Trelissick & Trewithen

Internationally renowned for its magnificent display of camellias, rhododendrons and magnolias, the gardens at Trewithen are described as a 'spectacle of pink and white'. Discover its rich history and magnificent floral displays before we head to the idyllic village of St Mawes for lunch. Savour a sumptuous three-course lunch with wine as you take in sea views from the Idle Rocks Hotel, situated on the harbourside of this charming Cornish village.

In the evening, a table d'hôte menu is served in the hotel restaurant.
