Co-ordinated fabrics complement wood-panelled walls and ceiling. Two comfortable armchairs provide daytime seating and a free-standing coffee table. Cupboards and a full length wardrobe provide ample storage. A large picture window and full length mirror enhance the spacious feel. ## 4 Krakow Poland

Once a royal capital with an extraordinary history, and now a lively university town with fashionable bars and restaurants, Krakow is a fascinating city with beautiful monuments and an exuberant atmosphere.

This morning the train makes a scheduled stop at Oswiecim, the station for Auschwitz-Birkenau where we will make a 2-hour visit to the location of the evocative concentration camp and museum. Declared by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site we embark upon a deeply moving guided tour which stands as a stark reminder of the horrors that took

place here. Today, Auschwitz is preserved as a museum for visitors to reflect on the horrors of the Holocaust and learn from them. (For ticketing purposes, the time of booking is for the time of booking for the Auschwitz-Birkenau visit).

From here we will continue to the centre of stunning Krakow where we will enjoy lunch in the city.



## 9 Prague Czech Republic

Today we join a vintage tram to travel through the city up the hill to Prague Castle area and a visit to the gothic St. Vitus Cathedral. The castle and its surrounding architectural gems occupy a hillside overlooking the city and river.

Following lunch there will be the opportunity for free time in the Old Town district, before returning to the train.



## 10 Salzburg Austria

Today we explore Salzburg at Mirabell Palace located in the heart of the city. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the baroque palace is easily one of the most iconic landmarks in the city. In more modern times, it was used in The Sound of Music.

A short distance from the Mirabell Palace is the Market Square (Marktplatz), where you can see the former Mozarteum, a museum. From here, cross the Makartsteg bridge into the old town and walk along the Getreidegasse, Salzburg's most famous street. The street is renowned for its wine bars and its birthplace of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart.

For more than 400 years, the Archbishop of Salzburg has owned the Mirabell Palace. The Palace has enchanted visitors with its 'trick' fountains. The Mirabell Palace is located in the south of Salzburg, and was a summer retreat for the Archbishops of Salzburg.

Its baroque exterior and exuberant interior may be the first things that come to mind when thinking of the Palace, but though the real draw is the ornate fountains (Wasserspiele) in the Mirabell gardens, which spray water in unexpected places.
