Krakow Poland

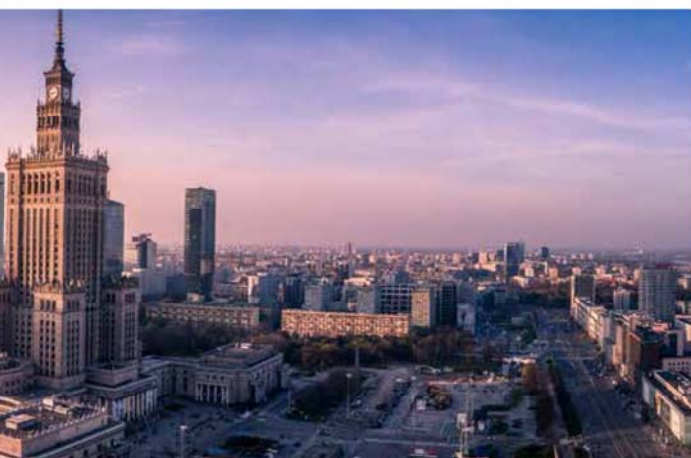
Once a royal capital with an extraordinary history, and now a lively university town with fashionable bars and restaurants, Krakow is a fascinating city with beautiful monuments and an exuberant atmosphere.

This morning the train makes a scheduled stop at Oswiecim, the station for Auschwitz-Birkenau where we will make a 2-hour visit to the location of the evocative concentration camp and museum. Declared by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site we embark upon a deeply moving guided tour which stands as a stark reminder of the horrors that took

place here. Today, Auschwitz is preserved as a museum for visitors to reflect on the Holocaust and learn from its history. (For ticketing purposes, please book the time of booking if you wish to visit Auschwitz-Birkenau).

From here we will continue to the centre of stunning Krakow where we will enjoy lunch in the heart of the city.

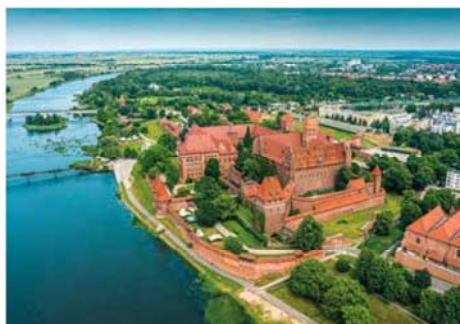

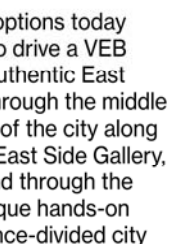
